Course Overview

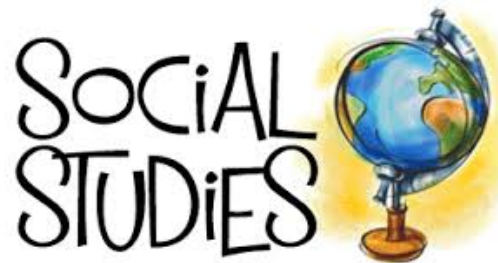
Social Studies 8 Overview

The Nova Scotia Grade 8 Social Studies Curriculum is focused on Canada and examining the geography, history and sociology of its people's. Themes such as identity, the environment, and defining events (both pre and post confederation) are major focal points of this course.

Assessment/Evaluation

A variety of methods of assessment and evaluation will be used in social studies 8 this year. These may include but are not limited to:

Checklists, observations, quizzes, assignments, portfolios, rubrics, tests, projects, journals and self/peer assessment.



Classwork & Homework

The Science 8 course is outcome based and is good foundation for all future senior level social studies courses.

At no point during the course will new material be sent home without proper introduction. But sometimes students may be asked to do some pre-research or finish an in-class assignment.
