



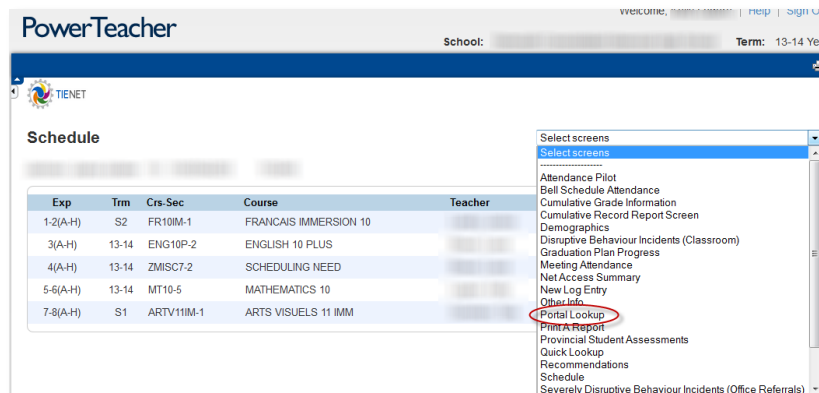
We've Enhanced the Student-Parent Portal

Student achievement information is now presented with a greater emphasis on the individual assessments and course outcomes for the entire course. An improved user experience is now in place for parents and students to view information related to assessments and outcomes. Information on attendance, late work, missing work, and achievement are all available to encourage ongoing communication and the improvement of student achievement.

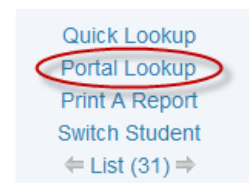
These enhancements were tailored specifically for our education system to align with our approach to assessment, evaluation and reporting. Subsequently, this provides our students and parents with a better overall picture of the student learning experience.

School staff now has the ability to view what the parents and students see either through PowerTeacher or PowerSchool Admin.

- In **PowerTeacher**, choose the option called **Portal Lookup** from the drop down list of screens available to view the student-parent portal screens.



- **PowerSchool Admin** has the **Portal Lookup** link listed directly under the **Quick Lookup** option.



The **Academic Achievement** section shows report card information from previous terms and years for students and parents.

A User Guide is available for students and parents which outlines functionality in the portal. School staff may also use this guide to better understand the information displayed.
